

NOMINATION FOR FELLOW OF NZIFST

CRITERIA FOR FELLOWSHIP

Any Professional Member of the NZIFST can be nominated as a Fellow provided they have:

EITHER been a Professional Member of the Institute for a period of no less than ten years;
OR been a Professional Member of the Institute for a period of no less than five years and in addition was a Professional Member of an equivalent institution involved with food science and technology for a period of not less than five years preceding their acceptance as a Professional Member of the Institute.
(Please contact the Executive Manager first to confirm eligibility)

AND made a substantial contribution to the profession of food science and technology, through outstanding service in at least one of the following areas:

- Research and development leading to creation of new knowledge
- Technology transfer and education
- Development of the food industry including promotion of its ethical standards and public image
- Development of the affairs of the Institute, its Branches or Divisions.

Council may limit the number of Fellows of the Institute.

The Membership Committee's decision is final with regard to approving nominations for Fellow.

NOMINATION PROCESS

Nominations must be:

- by any group of THREE financial Fellow or Professional Members of the Institute. Each nominator must have known the nominee for at least 5 years.
- accompanied by a written statement or CV outlining the career of the nominee. This should be not more than 500 words. (Note – this is to be to the best of the nominators' knowledge, preferably without contacting the nominee)
- accompanied by supporting statement(s) signed by all three nominators which show clearly how they believe the nominee has made a substantial contribution to the profession of food science and technology, through outstanding service in at least one of the following areas (please state the area(s)):
 - Research and development leading to creation of new knowledge,
 - Technology transfer and education,
 - Development of the food industry including promotion of its ethical standards and public image,
 - Development of the affairs of the Institute, its Branches or Divisions.

FELLOWSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT & PRESENTATION

New Fellows will be publicly announced and certificates presented at the NZIFST Awards Dinner which is held in conjunction with the Annual Conference in late June each year. Successful nominees will be advised of their nomination to Fellow and invited to the dinner to receive their award. A condition of this award is that the nominee must be present to receive it. Any nominee unable to be present will have their award held over until the following year and will not be able to claim Fellow status in the interim. Nominees are entitled to one complimentary ticket to the dinner. Fellowship is acknowledged via a citation and framed certificate, and all new Fellows will feature in *FoodNZ* journal.
