

# NZIFST EMERGING LEADER AWARD

# **PURPOSE of AWARD**

This award is to recognise a young technologist/scientist/engineer for their endeavour or achievement, AND leadership potential, within the food industry.

All sectors of the food industry and all roles are eligible.

[NOTE: From 2022, this award combines and replaces the Young Technologist Award and the IFT Emerging Leaders Network (ELN) Programme award]

# **CRITERIA**

The nominee will be:

- A current Standard or Professional member of NZIFST with at least 3 years' continuous membership.
- Aged 30 years or under.

# **NATURE of the AWARD:**

- The award winner will receive \$NZ 2,000 (incl GST) towards their professional development and this must be commenced within 12 months of receiving the award (prize to be paid on submission of receipts following confirmed attendance at the event).
- The award winner will be announced and presented annually in a ceremony at the NZIFST's direction. This will usually be at the annual conference.
- The award winner should intend to be present at the ceremony in order to receive their award.
- Nominations will be considered only once; in the year they are submitted. They will not be held over to another year but may be resubmitted.
- In any one year, the NZIFST reserves the right to not select a recipient for this award.

# **NOMINATION PROCESS**

TWO nominators are required; these may be an NZIFST member, or employer, supervisor, or a senior colleague of the nominee.

### **Documentation Required:**

- (1) A career outline or CV for the nominee.
- (2) A supporting statement, confirming how the nominee meets the purpose for the award.
- (3) Nominator's signed declarations.

The awards committee reserves the right to interview nominees.
