The NZ Pet Food Industry: Transition from a low-value local focus to high-value export focus

The Pet Food Industry in New Zealand has traditionally utilised relatively low value animal by-product ingredients in canned, dog roll and dry biscuit formats. In the last 20 years, the industry has been transformed with high value export products now produced and additional formats including extruded, air-dried, freeze-dried and pouch formats and with massive investment into new facilities around the country. In this talk we will take you through this journey and describe the current structure of the industry which is starting to grow beyond the supermarket pet food aisles, online and into speciality channels locally and internationally


